

# NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION

## HARDYSTON TOWNSHIP PUBLIC SCHOOLS

### 2019-2020 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Children who will be five years old on or before October 1, 2019, are eligible to register for the 2019-2020 school year.

\*\*\*Please note: Students currently attending the Hardyston Preschool Program are also required to register for kindergarten on one of the dates below.

Please bring **ALL** necessary documentation, as listed below, to kindergarten registration. In addition, appointments for mandatory Kindergarten screening will be scheduled at this time.

- Proof of Residency (Please note that this requirement must be met for all new students registering regardless of whether a sibling is already registered.)

**At the time of registration, you will need to present two forms of proof of residency.**

**Homeowners:** picture ID, most recent mortgage statement/tax bill & current utility bill.

**Renters:** picture ID, current rental lease agreement and current utility bill (cable, electric, etc.)

***\*If you are living with an individual or family residing in Hardyston Township, they must complete an “Application by a Resident” and provide a copy of their deed and a current utility bill. This application needs to be notarized. Please inquire in the office if you need this document.***

**You will also need the following in order to complete registration:**

- Original Birth Certificate
- Custodian/Guardianship Papers (if applicable)
- Physical check-up from private medical doctor (must be dated between **September 5, 2018 and September 5, 2019**)
- Doctor's certificate of immunization against the following:
  1. DPT – 4 doses – Fourth dose must be on or after fourth birthday; if not, a fifth dose will be needed.
  2. Polio – 3 doses – Third dose must be on or after fourth birthday; if not, a fourth dose will be needed.
  3. Measles (Rubeola) – 2 doses of a measles containing vaccine; the first dose must be after the first birthday.
  4. Mumps – 1 dose
  5. German Measles (Rubella) – 1 dose
  6. Hepatitis B – 3 doses
  7. Varicella (Chicken Pox Vaccine) — 1 dose after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday or documentation that child had the disease.
