COMMUNITY EVENTS:

Winter Social	Full District family night out that includes: DJ, activities, snacks and a WHOLE LOT OF FUN!

General Support	Ad hoc school support as needed throughout the year (ex: copies/laminating).
Mini Grants (faculty program)	Assist our 1 st VP providing classroom materials to enhance learning environment
Appreciation Events	(Various dates) coordinate gifts/meals to show our faculty/staff and bus drivers our appreciation!
4th Grade Moving Up Breakfast	(Recommended for 3 rd grade parents) set up breakfast for 4 th grade families the morning of the moving up ceremony in June.
8th Grade Graduation Breakfast	(Recommended for 7 th grade parents) set up breakfast for 8 th grade families on Graduation day in June. This allows them to enjoy the day stress-free!

Hospitality	Help PTA purchase needed supplies for events (ex: Academic Bowl, 5 th grade L.E.A.D. graduation)
PTA Grants	Research grants that the PTA is eligible for and submit applications to receive additional funding to support our efforts
PTA Representative	Represent PTA at various functions (ex: Back to School Nights, orientations, etc.)
