

You should stay home or will be sent home if you have:

2 Of the Following:

Headaches
Body Aches
Chills
Sore Throat
Nausea
Fatigue
Runny Nose

OR 1 Of the Following:

Fever of 100.0F or above
New Cough
Shortness of Breath
Difficulty Breathing
Loss of Taste or Smell
Vomiting
Diarrhea

OR You have:

Been within 6 feet for an accumulative total of 15 minutes or more within the 24 hour period to a person that has tested positive for COVID 19.

When Can I Return to School?

Positive COVID- 19 TEST TEST

You may return after 10 days
AND
At Least 72 hours NO FEVER
Without taking medication
AND
Symptoms have improved

NO COVID- 19 TEST

You may return after 10 days
AND
At Least 72 Hours NO FEVER
Without taking medication
AND
Symptoms have improved
OR
Doctor's Note Indicating an Alternative Diagnosis

NEGATIVE COVID- 19

You may return when at least
72 Hours NO FEVER
Without Taking Medication
AND
Respiratory Symptoms
have improved

*** IF FEVER IS THE ONLY SYMPTOM YOU MAY RETURN AFTER AT LEAST 72 HOURS NO FEVER WITHOUT MEDICATION***

***If you are deemed a "close contact" this means you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. You will need to stay home until 14 days after last exposure and maintain social distance (at least 6 feet) from others at all times.**

IF YOU HAVE A COVID TEST DO NOT RETURN TO SCHOOL UNTIL YOU ARE PROVIDED WITH THE RESULTS.
