#### **REGIONAL COVID UPDATE**

According to the Department of Health, COVID-19 cases are increasing rapidly in the Northwest Region of the state. While this week's COVID-19 Regional Activity Level is still at "Moderate Risk," we should anticipate reaching "High Risk" in the next week or two.

Following NJDOH's COVID-19 Public Health Recommendations for LHDs for K-12 Schools districts should prepare to take the following actions in consultation with the Sussex County Health Department if we move to the "High Risk" category.

- Consider implementing fully remote learning. Parents should prepare for the possibility of needing increased childcare should schools pivot to remote learning.
- Restrict activities that involve interaction with multiple cohorts (sports and other extracurricular activities).
- If in-person learning continues, implement enhanced contact tracing and exclusion of close contacts of students and staff who have COVID-19 compatible symptoms <u>even if not yet tested</u>. This would include students or staff who call in sick.

More information will be forthcoming in the next week about the appropriate action to take, based on our county and regional data.
