## 1st and 2nd Grade Winter Concert



## **Travel Guidelines**

Hardyston School District strongly encourages you to follow CDC recommendations; however, they are not enforced by the district. Please contact your school nurse if you have questions or concerns.

Currently, the CDC recommends delaying travel until you are fully vaccinated.

**Domestic Travel** 

According to the CDC, unvaccinated individuals who do travel should get tested 1-3 days before their trip, 3-5 days after travel, and stay home and self-quarantine for 7 days after domestic travel. For those traveling to New Jersey, domestic travel is defined as lasting 24 hours or longer to states or US territories other than those connected to New Jersey, such as Pennsylvania, New York, and Delaware

For more information, refer to the CDC's guidance for domestic travel.

#### International Travel

The CDC requires all air passengers arriving in the United States from a foreign country to get tested for COVID-19 no more than 3 days before their flight departs and to present the negative result or documentation of having recovered from COVID-19 to the airline before boarding the flight.
