Updated COVID Guidelines

The <u>COVID-19 Activity Level Report</u> is now <u>VERY HIGH - RED</u>. At this time, the only change in guidance is to strongly encourage extracurricular sports team participants to be vaccinated, since masks cannot be worn during play. It is also recommended to test athletes twice per week. New guidance from the Department of Education will be coming soon, and when it does, it will be shared with the Hardyston community.

Please speak with your children about the need to wear masks correctly at all times. Too many children have to be told to pull their mask over their nose throughout the day. Omicron is extremely contagious and it is imperative that their masks are worn properly indoors at school.

Please keep your child home if they have been tested but are awaiting results. Too many students are coming to school and being told mid-day that they tested positive. Please have patience and wait for the results to come before you send your child to school.

The New Jersey Department of Health's K-12 current guidance on quarantine periods for close contacts is as follows, and <u>please note that it does NOT follow the shortened CDC timeline:</u>

"Close contacts who are not fully vaccinated should be excluded for 10 days (in absence of testing) from the date of last contact. Close contacts who test negative during the 5th through 7th days following the date of last contact may return on the 8th day or thereafter."

The above guidance applies regardless of the COVID-19 Activity Level (CALI). **As a reminder, all close contacts that are fully vaccinated and asymptomatic are not required to quarantine.**
