Bus Information

Every summer, bus routes and times may change. Please check your child's parent portal for up to date bus information. This can be found under the 'Transportation' tab.

Please arrive at the bus stop *10 minutes before the scheduled time and please wait at least 10 minutes after* the scheduled time for the bus to arrive. On the first few days of school, buses will likely run late as the drivers and children get used to the stops. Thank you for your patience.

To make boarding the buses faster, please have your child standing at the bus stop. Thank you for your cooperation.

From the Health Office

A complete physical is needed if your child wants to participate in any school-related extracurricular activity. Sports physicals are due by September 1. *You may drop off your physicals prior to September 1 at either school Monday - Thursday, 8 AM - 3 PM.*

Every student entering grade 6 requires the following immunizations:

- DTaP
- Meningococcal

Documentation must be submitted to the Health Office by **September 15, 2023**. Students who do not have documentation of the above immunizations will be excluded from school.
