# Elementary School Pickup

### Two updates:

- 1. Please do not let your car idle when you are parked in the pickup area. Idling for more than 3 minutes is illegal. In addition, our unit ventilators bring outside air into the school. Vehicle exhaust will enter the school the longer cars idle.
- 2. We now have 92 parent pickups daily approximately one-third of the elementary enrollment. This is causing busing delays. Buses need to be the priority. To rectify that, the majority of vehicles in the parent pickup area will be held until buses depart. Please consider allowing your child to ride the bus. Doing so allows for a much smoother dismissal process.


