In attendance from Hardyston were BOE members Mr. Alfano, Mr. Drelick, Mr. Hoffman, Mr. Van Ginneken, and Superintendent Mr. Ryder.

Wallkill Valley needs one other district to formally join them in order for the study to be approved. Once approved, all the sending districts will be represented in the study. 
ATTENTION MIDDLE SCHOOL PARENTS

Dear Middle School Parents.

Within the coming weeks the dress code policy will be reviewed with all students. Starting Monday 3/18/24 students who come to school violating the dress code will be asked to change. If the student does not have clothing to change into, a parent will be called to bring a change of clothes. While an all-inclusive list of inappropriate attire is not possible, the following specific restrictions are examples of clothing deemed as improper for school use:

- 1. Any apparel which refers to alcoholic beverages, narcotics, or substance abuse;
- 2. Clothing which is too tight or too loose so as to inhibit movement;
- 3. Garments with pornographic messages and/or inappropriate statements;
- 4. Shirts and blouses which expose a student's stomach;
- 5 Off the chaulder streetess tops:

- 6. Skirts, dresses, shorts, or pants that are short enough to potentially impact health or hygiene, or long enough to be a safety concern (tripping);
- 7. Bathing suits or underwear;
- 8. Hats, visors, or bandannas;
- 9. Any item of clothing or accessory that could cause injury to others or damage to the school facilities or school equipment;
- 10. Sneakers with wheels; Shoes or sneakers, with backs for support, must be worn at all times.
