#### Did you know?

- A price comparison was done with private local preschools to see how much money Hardyston parents are saving with **our free, full-day preschool** program. Based on the lowest priced local program, parents pay \$1,080 per month for a full-day program.
- Next school year we will have 75 students enrolled in preschool. Our program saves Hardyston residents **\$81,000 per month**, which translates to \$810,000 for the 10-month school year!
