Parent Portal - Opens Thursday, 8/21 at 10 am

The parent portal will be open for teacher assignments, schedules, and bus information beginning on August 21st at 10 AM. If this is your first year in Hardyston School District, your portal login code and instructions on how to access the portal will be emailed to you the morning of 8/21.

**Please note that in order to view information on the portal, there are required forms that will need to be completed first. To make this process as easy as possible, you may wish to consider

logging in from a computer or laptop instead of a cell phone.

Bus Information

Please be sure to check your child's **Transportation tab** in the Parent Portal once the portal opens on August 21st. Due to changes in bus assignments and routes over the summer, **bus numbers and pick-up/drop-off times may have changed.** Thank you for your attention to this important update as we prepare for the new school year!

Please arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes before the scheduled time and please wait at least 10 minutes after the scheduled time for the bus to arrive. On the first few days of school, buses will likely run late as the drivers and children get used to the stops. Thank you for your patience.

To make boarding the buses faster, please have your child standing at the bus stop. Thank you for your cooperation.

Physicals and Immunizations

All newly enrolled Pre-K students and all students entering Kindergarten must submit a physical exam dated after September 4, 2024, along with up-to-date immunization records before the first day of school. They can be dropped off at the school, faxed, or emailed to the school nurse, Mrs. Stoffels, at wstoffels@htps.org.

Medication Drop Off

If your child requires daily medication or uses an epi-pen or inhaler, you may drop it off to the school nurse on Tuesday, September 2 or Wednesday, September 3 from 12:30-3:30.
