Bus and teacher assignments are now viewable on the portal

The parent portal is now open for teacher assignments, schedules, and bus information. If this is your first year in Hardyston School District, your portal login code and instructions on how to access the portal was emailed to you on the morning of 8/21. If you need assistance, please call the main office.

**Please note that in order to view information on the portal, there are required forms that will need to be completed first. To make this process as easy as possible, you may wish to consider logging in from a computer or laptop instead of a cell phone.

Bus Information

Due to changes in bus assignments and routes over the summer, **bus numbers and pick-up/drop-off times may have changed.** Thank you for your attention to this important update as we prepare for the new school year!

Please arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes before the scheduled time and please wait at least 10 minutes after the scheduled time for the bus to arrive. On the first few days of school, buses will likely run late as the drivers and children get used to the stops. Thank you for your patience.

To make boarding the buses faster, please have your child standing at the bus stop. Thank you for your cooperation.

Free and Reduced Lunch Applications

<u>Free and reduced lunch applications are available online</u> and a paper copy will provided on the first day of school. Please note that free lunch will not be provided until the application is processed

and a family qualifies. During that time, please send your child to school with lunch or <u>add money</u> to their lunch account through payschoolcentral.com

If your child is NOT taking the bus home, you need to use Pick Up Patrol

PickUp Patrol is a system Hardyston School District uses to manage dismissal. It eliminates the need to write notes or make phone calls when changing your student's dismissal plans. It is assumed that all students will ride the bus home unless you change your preference in Pick Up Patrol. Please be sure to log in to set up your preference. New parents, you will receive a welcome email inviting you to set up an account.

Please note Preschool students do not use Pick Up Patrol because transportation choices were already noted through the transportation survey that was sent out earlier this summer.

Important Hardyston Elementary Information

Drop off and pick up takes place behind the school.

<u>Drop Off</u> is between 8:40 am and 8:50 am. Please remember that drop off is a flowing line of cars and parents are not permitted to walk students to the door. Thank you for your cooperation.

<u>Pick Up</u> is in the back of the building. Parents will be directed to park and may exit the driveway only when signaled to do so.

Arrival times for pick up:

- Preschool parents may arrive prior to 3 pm and must display their PK parking pass to park
- Kinder grade 4 parents will not be able to enter the driveway before 3:10

Buses will leave the school at approximately 3:40 pm. During the first few days of school, buses may arrive home a few minutes later than what would be typical as bus drivers and students are getting use to the routine.

Kindergarten, Wednesday, 9/3 at 4:30 pm

Kindergarten students should accompany their parents as they will have the opportunity to meet their teacher and classmates and see their classroom. Students will then tour the school with our 4th grade students. Please report directly to your child's classroom.

*Parents and kindergarten students only. No siblings, please.

Grades 1-4, Thursday, 9/18

To accommodate families who have students in multiple grade levels, there will be two sessions.

- Grades 1 & 2 will be held from 6 7:00 *parents report directly to the classroom at 6 pm
- Grades 3 & 4 will be held from 7 8:00 *parents report directly to the classroom at 7 pm
- Assigned Arts, intervention, speech teachers, and (select) CST members will be available in the cafeteria from 6:30 7:30 pm
- The Hardyston PTA and other organizations will also be in the cafeteria from 6:30 8 pm

Physicals and Immunizations

All newly enrolled Pre-K students and all students entering Kindergarten must submit a physical exam dated after September 4, 2024, along with up-to-date immunization records before the first day of school. They can be dropped off at the school, faxed, or emailed to the school nurse, Mrs. Stoffels, at wstoffels@htps.org.

Medication Drop Off

If your child requires daily medication or uses an epi-pen or inhaler, you may drop it off to the school nurse on Tuesday, September 2 or Wednesday, September 3 from 12:30-3:30.
